Number of scholarships: 1

Scholarship in the amount of PLN 4.276,00/ month (tax-free) up to the mid-term assessment and PLN 5.131,00/ month (tax-free) after the mid-term assessment for a total period of 48 months.

The scholarship will be awarded by means of a competition, the rules of which are set out in Annex 2 to the Regulations on granting funds for the implementation of tasks financed by the National Science Center in the field of research projects as an attachment to the resolution of the National Council Science Center No. 90/2019 of September 12, 2019. The PI of the project will be the PhD supervisor. In the event of resignation of the selected candidate, the right is reserved to indicate the next candidate from the ranking list.

The doctoral candidate must:

- hold university degrees with outstanding academic track records in both philosophy and psychology, and must be formally entitled to pursue doctoral studies (PhD) in philosophy;
- have a recorded background in phenomenology and psychoanalysis;
- be proficient in the project's working languages, English and German, in both spoken and written form.

It is desirable that the doctoral candidate:

- has a documented background in phenomenological embodiment studies;
- is experienced in giving presentations in academia (e.g. has given presentations at scientific conferences, has teaching experience in university contexts);
- has an international profile (e.g. has studied abroad, has attended international scientific conferences).

It is an advantage if the doctoral candidate:

- has worked before with the manuscripts of Edmund Husserl;
- has attended courses in advanced training in psychoanalysis;
- has first experience in scientific work (e.g. has worked as a research assistant or in a similar position with tasks pertaining to scientific research and dissemination of results);
- has documented knowledge of university processes and structures (e.g. has worked as a research assistant or in a similar position with tasks pertaining to organization of academic events or similar).

In addition to the academic qualifications, the ability to work in an autonomous and structured manner, openness to interdisciplinary work and a high level of communicative competence and teamwork are required. Active participation in the events of the graduate school is expected.

Persons interested in participating in the competition are invited to submit the following documents:

- a) cover letter;
- b) a CV containing a list of publications, presentations at conferences and other scientific achievements;
- c) scan of degree diplomas;
- d) scan of the document confirming formal entitlement to study for a PhD in Philosophy
- e) selected text or publication of own authorship (e.g. report, article, master's thesis chapter)

Tasks:

- Analysis of original texts including unpublished work of Edmund Husserl on embodiment and drive, and Sigmund Freud's work on individuation, drive and sexuality
- Active participation in Doctoral Research Classes and Workshops, monthly meetings with PI
- Co-organization of Scientific Conferences
- Participation in the PI's research group activities
- Application to NAWA for one semester abroad
- One abstract each year for international calls to present results of ongoing work at philosophy workshops and conferences
- Research results are to be submitted for publication in the form of papers to thematically appropriate top-tier academic journals in philosophy
- final results are to be integrated into a dissertation which is to be submitted for publication as a book in English by an international publishing house.

The successful candidate will be registered as PhD student at the Graduate School for Social Research (GSSR).

The competition will take place in two stages. In the first stage, the recruitment commission will make a preliminary assessment of the candidates on the basis of submitted documents. At the second stage of the competition, the highest rated candidates will be invited to an interview.

The interviews are scheduled for **September 9th, 2020** and will take place **on Zoom** (due to COVID-19).

The competition will be decided no later than **September 15th, 2020**, and the recruitment results will be published at <http://www.ifispan.pl/category/oferty-pracy/konkursy/>

Information regarding the processing of personal data
