### **WORKSHOP CONTENT**

The workshop on legalization of stay and work of foreign students, scholars and highly trained workers (blue card), from UE and other countries.

The workshop will specify the differences between the Ukraine, Bielarus, Turkey and other countries and specifically to describe the special situation of Ukraine citizens covered with temporary security.

- Short introduction into the measures of administrative and material law (practical aspects only – plus the Mazovian Voivodship Office)
