With studies at the University of Bucharest, SNSPA, University of Oxford, Paris-Sorbonne and the European University Institute in Florence, his research and publications focus on political representation, welfare state, migration and cosmopolitan political theory. He is a member of the research teams of European research projects aimed at benchmarking democratic innovations in public deliberation, migration, urban rights and policies, as well as analyzing threats to academic freedom.
